Online Giving: You can do this easily through our website (www.wcclc.org). From our homepage, simply click the drop-down tab in the upper right-hand corner and then click the "Donate" link. On the donate page, you will see a button that says, "Donate Online Now!". Clicking this button will take you to our online giving portal. From here, simply follow the directions on the page and your contribution will be sent directly to the WCCLC.

Mail-In Giving: You can make checks payable to Walton County Christian Learning Center and mail to address below.
